The novel coronavirus (aka: Covid-19) certainly affected almost everything in our lives during 2020. We were exposed to conditions and restrictions that none of us had previously experienced. Typically, only poor weather conditions deterred some of us from physically participating in the celebration at the Annapolis National Cemetery.

However, this past December, Covid-19 made it necessary to alter the wreath laying ceremony. Organizers were prevented from holding the typical public ceremony and participants were required to pre-register for specific timeslots in order to place wreaths on the veteran's graves. Not to be deterred from the mission, on December 19th, fifteen ACPSAA members braved the conditions and Covid restrictions to place sponsored

wreaths on graves and honor those interred. However, that's only part of the story. The REAL story is the incredible wreath sponsorship response from our chapter's members, families, and friends. Our Chapter's 2020 campaign target sought sponsorship of 220 wreaths. Even in the face of Covid-19 and its economic deterrents, not only did our total sponsorships reach target, but they completely exceeded every expectation. Our Chapter's total wreath sponsorships reached a total of **361 wreaths** – that's 60% over target and the largest number of single year sponsorships in our Chapters seven-year history in Wreaths Across America participation. To all of you that sponsored and those that helped on wreath unloading, ceremony and clean-up days, be proud! **You MADE A DIFFERENCE!**

A time capsule from 1949 was discovered during renovations in the Willard Building. The time capsule carried a variety of papers from the Bursar's Office and the Registrar Office as the Willard Building housed these offices in 1949. A Daily Collegian from March 3, 1949 was also included where the headline referenced Penn State's first double graduation ceremony. There were also documents about the growth of the student body from veterans post WWII. Plans were made to replace the time capsule with updated documents that represent Penn State in the 21st century.
