She has also overseen seven of the top 10 fundraising years in Penn State Athletics history.

Barbour stated, "These last eight years have been the most incredible and satisfying for my The career. passion, commitment and the purpose with which the Penn State Community purses excellence is like nothing I've ever experienced, and I am honored and priviledged to have had the opportunity to serve Penn State students, coaches, faculty, our incredible community."


SUPPORT TEAM ANNAPOLIS & SPECIAL OLYMPICS
