## 2015 Fall Service Project – Wreaths Across America™ ACPSAA Members exhibit a philanthropic resolve

In its third year supporting Wreath Across America<sup>™</sup>, ACPSAA Membership answered the call in splendid fashion. We raised and donated \$2,650.00 --a 16% increase over our 2014 campaign-- sponsoring 265 of the 2900+ wreaths placed to honor the sacrifices made by the veterans interred at The Annapolis National Cemetery. This was a significant impact on the overall WAA campaign as *this was the FIRST year* that the total WAA collections funded wreaths for <u>EVERY</u> grave in the cemetery! Additionally, 7 Chapter Members assisted with wreath delivery/unloading, 25+ Members participated in the Wreath Laying Ceremony and 16 Members assisted with the January wreath clean-up at the Cemetery.

Wreaths Across America<sup>™</sup> is a national charity whose mission is to "Remember. Honor. Teach." -- remember our fallen heroes, honor those who serve, and teach our children about the sacrifices made by veterans and their families to preserve our freedoms. Wreaths Across America supporters sponsor wreaths

that are placed on veteran's graves in all U.S. National Cemeteries at separate, yet simultaneous, ceremonies in December.

Annapolis is home to the U.S. Naval Academy, and many residents are very aware of the commitments and sacrifices made by members serving in our Armed Forces. However, its often easy to forget that a great number of these veterans have made the ultimate sacrifice. Nearly every Annapolitan knows of Arlington National Cemetery, but many are unaware that there are two National Cemeteries right here in Annapolis. One is on the US Navy Academy grounds, the other is adjacent to the intersection of West Street and Tyler Avenues. ACPSAA's efforts focus on the latter, since over the past 10 years, the Annapolis fundraising efforts of Wreaths Across America™ could yield only about 20% of the wreaths needed to honor the 2994 veterans at rest there.

The money raised and donated by our Chapter over the last three years has had a growing impact on that total ---raising awareness of Penn State and its Alumni in the greater Annapolis area. More importantly, 2015 was <u>FIRST</u> time wreaths could be placed at EVERY stone in that place of honor.
