## **Letter from the Board**

Did you know the 1<sup>st</sup> scholarship fund was established in 2003 by the Annapolis chapter for Penn State students? Through fund raising and generous donations, the Annapolis chapter was able to pledge \$25,000 to establish an endowment. That year 2 students from our local area were awarded some scholarship money. **Not every Penn State Chapter has been able to establish an endowment to offer scholarship money.** Through continuous donations, raffles and other activities sponsored by the Annapolis chapter, we can give back to the next generation of Penn Staters.

It's hard to believe that 10 years have passed since I have been on the scholarship committee, 8 of those years as Committee Chair. Over the course of time, our chapter has raised over \$100,000 and awarded it to talented and worthy students. The Scholarship committee has read and reviewed hundreds of applications and essays which has not been an easy task. These students are talented, determined, spirited and motivated to be successful. On the essay portion, students had to answer 2 questions. This year one of the questions was "Tell us about a time you failed and how that impacted you".

#### Let me share some excerpts...

"I tried out for the soccer team and didn't make it. I failed. ....I decided I wasn't going to sit in defeat and tried out for the cross country team. Barely making the team, I knew I had to put the work in...I placed 11<sup>th</sup> in the state. Failure closed the door that I was determined to walk through, but also opened a new door. The biggest thing I learned was that sometimes failure is just the start to a big success story that no one sees coming".

#### Another candidate shared...

"I applied to become a Paterno fellow which meant taking honors classes...I could not get myself to work...I had been dropped from the Paterno Honors program failing to meet their grade requirements. I was crushed. I felt like I failed myself and lost out on the only opportunity I had at Penn State. I realized I needed to make a change... No more would I cling to missed opportunities, instead I would take advantage of the ones still around. I became the master of my own destiny... Penn State doesn't give you experiences, it gives you opportunities."

#### And another....

"Throughout my academic journey, I had always found school to be relatively easy...then came my Chem class test...I was overwhelmed with distress and failed the test. This was the worst I've ever done on an exam in my entire life...I fell short of my own expectations...I believed I was a failure. I made the commitment to attend my professor's office hours...this made all the difference. Although this score initially devastated me, it ultimately served as a catalyst for personal and academic growth. It imparted valuable lessons on resilience, communication and perseverance, qualities that will benefit me for the rest of my schooling and future career".

Although the essay is only 1 component, scholarship awards are based on a combination of criteria: academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community service, volunteer work, professional work and internships. We are looking for well rounded students who we believe will make a lasting contribution to Penn State.

Once again we have been able to award several students scholarship monies this year. Helping the next generation is one of our chapter's highest priorities! Please consider making a donation today so we can continue to help the next generation of Penn Staters! WE ARE...

Prior to July  $1^{\rm st}$  2021, a student-athlete could not monetize from things like creating a YouTube channel, hosting a camp or selling a signed jersey. But as of July 1 2021, student-athletes across the country can now profit from their NIL.
